## 30HOUR CHILDREN

If your child is turning 3 soon, please Carry out 30 hour eligibility check as you might be entitled to 30 hour free child care.

**Parents that already have a 30 hour code please refresh your code before a new term starts.**

30hours children pay a top up fee of £5.00 a day term time only. The hours we offer for 30 hours children are 9 till 3:30 every day term time. fee must be paid even if your child is off. If you give notice that you are taking the child on holiday, then you don't have to pay the fee for the time they are off on holiday.

## Illness

if your child has diarrhoea, vomiting or temperature. they should not come to nursery. Keep them home for 48 hours.

Please let staff know on arrival if your child is coming with any injury at home or outside the nursery
